### **P.E. days** – Friday

### **Homework**

#### **Reading**

Class texts set by teachers to read, discuss and share back in class. Reading homework will be set from the W/C Monday 4<sup>th</sup> September. This is essential preparation for your child's guided reading sessions. Reading stickers are awarded weekly for reading at home on a minimum of 3x per week. This can include other texts in addition to class readers. Free choice books are available for all children to take home and enjoy.

#### **Maths**

Y6 have My Maths activities set to complete every Friday and will be due in the following Thursday. Learning number facts and times tables will be practised in school and tested on a Friday. The children will have individual record cards which will help show you what they are learning in school to enable you to support their practice at home.

#### **Spelling –**

As part of the Read Write Inc. spelling scheme in school, children from Y2 onwards will have a list of words recorded in their homework book. Your child needs to practise these at least three times at home to be rewarded with a homework sticker.

#### **Other Homework**

From time to time there may be other individual homework tasks linked to topic work in class. These will be sent home via book bags. Also in the Spring Term additional work may be sent home to support your child with their SATs preparation.

Thank you for your continued support. Work done at home is key for the learning we do in school and in enabling children to achieve their best.
