

Maths

We will be continuing to follow the 'White Rose Maths' scheme (see links below). In the autumn term we will focus on place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication and division. Links will also be made to our theme of 'Yorkshire'.

Art

We will look at the work of Yorkshire sculptor Barbara Hepworth. This will include the children making their own miniature soap sculptures as well as larger group pieces based on the style of Hepworth.

We will also explore photography. We will learn how to frame a shot more confidently and how to edit our photos to achieve a desired result.

Music

We will follow the 'Churanga' music scheme. Y3: 'Let Your Spirit Fly' Y4: 'Mama Mia' based on the music of Abba. Both years will further develop their skills with glockenspiels.

PE

This term we will be working with specialist teachers in Dance. We will increase our confidence in controlling our movements and linking these together in increasingly complex sequences.

Science

In Y3 we will explore plants, focusing on those found in Yorkshire. We will then move onto looking at animals and humans, exploring nutrition and the skeleton.

In Y4 we will explore habitats, focusing on those found in Yorkshire. We will then move onto looking at animals and humans, exploring teeth and digestion.

English

This term the writing genres studied will link to our guided reading texts and the theme of Yorkshire.

- Information texts
- Persuasive Texts – Leaflets
- Poetry
- Narrative (with a focus on speech)

Y3 – Greater focus on introducing concepts and the features of each genre and starting to become confident with these.

Y4 – Greater independence with understanding and applying the taught concepts confidently and across different contexts.

Discovering Yorkshire

This term we will be exploring our local county. We will launch with our very own 'Tickton Show', embracing the traditions of agricultural shows. We will then close the topic with a Yorkshire Showcase which will include a 'Great Yorkshire Bake-Off', celebrating our learning and local food.

Computing

In computing, will explore databases. We will make links to census information and learn how to create our own simple databases.

Design and Technology

We will further develop our skills in working with food. Recognising the important role of local produce and using these to create our own 'Yorkshire' inspired dishes.

History

We will explore the local area and wider context of 'Yorkshire' through historical and geographical sources. We will explore our rural history and the impact of the industrial revolution and how this has shaped parts of the county.

Geography

We will explore the country of Yorkshire though a focus on map work. We will use maps and atlases and create our own, growing confident in reading and drawing our own OS map symbols.

RE

We will continue to follow the East Riding Agree syllabus. Y3 will complete the unit 'Remembering' looking at ceremonies and festivals of remembrance. Y4 will further develop their understanding of faith in the local and wider communities of Yorkshire through the unit 'Belief in the Community'.
