Mrs Ridsdale and her team are preparing a Queen's Platinum Jubilee Lunch on **Wednesday 25th May.** The main meal will be a 'Big Foot Sausage' or two Quorn sausages, served in a hot dog roll with fried onions & tomato ketchup, shoe-string fries and spaghetti hoops or salad. The children will have had their lunch so won't need very much to eat, e.g. a small sandwich & a bun would be sufficient.
